Focus items for Phase 2 study – Hinkley Center scope

Cities data needed for complete picture – solicit information and funding (see below)

Followup with small counties, is it worth the effort?

Impact of HB 7135

Composting is highest priority due to short deadline and County responsibility

Opportunity to cooperate now! – plan, show cost-benefit, implement

75% Recycling goal – Statewide “aspiration”

Possible revisions in 2009 legislature

Opportunity to bring in Cities, Schools to cooperative effort

League of Cities knows and has listed info for cities, but solid waste staff may

not know full impact.

Waste composition study essential to planning

FDEP online calculator works for “average” not local specifics

Need to know how much of what materials are generated from various

categories of generators (SF- Res, Multifamily Res, Institutional – including governments, Commercial, Industrial) before you plan a diversion program

Organizational options

Potential formats, legal requirements, capabilities, and characteristics

“advantages and disadvantages”

Review existing and emerging disposal technologies status

Economic analysis – watershed size for disposal options, ? priority

Local political positions – may be too soon
